WHEREAS, recognition u/s14 NCTE Act, 1993 was granted to the institution namely Kamaraj College of Education, Nadar Mahajana Sangam, Pazhavilai Post, Kanyakumari District, Pin-629501, TamilNadu run by Nadar Mahajana Sangam, Pazhavilai Post, Kanyakumari District, Pin-629501, TamilNadu vide SRC order No.F.TN/SEC/SRO/NCTE/2005-2006/4173 on 23.11.2005 for conducting Secondary B.Ed. course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2005-2006.

- 2. AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution has submitted affidavit dt.26.02.2015 for its willingness of two units in B.Ed. course and adherence of provisions of new Regulations. A revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 12.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.
- 3. AND WHEREAS, the matter regarding compliance by the institution of the condition of the revised recognition order, was placed before the SRC in its 388th Meeting held on 14th & 15th September 2020 and the Committee decided that Show Cause Notice be issued to all such institutions which have not submitted compliance. Accordingly, as per decision of SRC a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 11.11.2021. The institution has submitted reply of Show Cause Notice on 06.12.2021.
- **4. AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 405th meeting held on 13th & 14th December 2021 considered the matter and committee decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice u/s 17 of NCTE Act, 1993. Accordingly, as per decision of SRC a Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 28.12.2021. The institution has submitted reply of Final Show Cause Notice vide letter dated 23.06.2022.
- **5. AND WHEREAS,** the SRC in its 412th Meeting held on 05th 06th July, 2022 considered the matter and decided as follows: -

"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

The Committee on the perusal of the reply submitted by the institution, decided that the continuation order be issued to the Institution Kamaraj College of Education, Survey No. 171/7, 171/8, 171/9, 172/7, Neendakarai Village, Agasteewara Taluk, Kanyakumari District, Tamilnadu-629501 for B.Ed. programme for 2 basic units of 50 student each.

- 6. NOW THEREFORE, this order is issued permitting the institution i.e., Kamaraj College of Education, Survey No. 171/7, 171/8, 171/9, 172/7, Neendakarai Village, Agasteewara Taluk, Kanyakumari District, Tamilnadu-629501 run by Nadar Mahajana Sangam, Pazhavilai Post, Kanyakumari District, Pin-629501, TamilNadu for Continuation of recognition for B.Ed. programme for two years duration with an annual intake of 2 basic units of 50 students each subject to fulfilment of the following conditions:
 - I. The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the FDRs or mortgaging them shall not be done.

II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.

- III. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.

- 7. Further, the institution is required to fulfill all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University /Body, the State Government etc. as applicable.
- **8.** The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee as Self Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
- 9. - i. The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
- j. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information if it so desires.
- Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.
- **10**. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.
- 11. The institution shall make available the list of students admitted on its official website.
- 12. The institution shall fill the information on GIS Portal on the NCTE Website.

ORDER

WHEREAS, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section(2) of Section 32 of the National Council for Teacher Education Act, 1993(73 of 1993), and in supersession of the National Council for Teacher Education [Recognition Norms and Procedure] Regulations, 2009, the National Council for Teacher Education has notified the Regulations, 2014 on 1.12.2014.

- 2. AND WHEREAS, the institution, Kamaraj College of Education, Nadar Mahajana Sangam, Pazhavilai Post, Kanyakumari District-629501, Tamilnadu has by affidavit consented to come under New Regulations and sought for two basic units in **B.Ed** which require additional facilities.
- 3. AND WHEREAS, on scrutiny it is found that the institution has not shifted to its own premises as stipulated in its Formal Recognition order dated 23.11.2005.
- **4. AND WHEREAS**, the SRC has decided to permit the institution to have two basic units of 50 students each subject to the institution fulfilling following conditions namely,
 - I. The institution shall submit all documents including land, building, Encumbrance Certificate, Land Use Certificate, Building Plan, approved staff list, pertaining to shifting to own premises to the SRC before 31st July, 2015 failing which recognition will be withdrawn.
 - II. The Regional Committees shall inspect the proposed premises during August-September-October, 2015 and if on inspection it is found that the institution dose not fulfill required norms of infrastructure recognition will be withdrawn.
 - III. Further, with regard to the second unit the institution shall create additional facilities that include (a) additional built-up area, (b) additional infrastructure, (c) additional funds, (d) additional staff as per Regulations, 2014 and inform Regional Committees with required documents by October 31, 2015.
 - IV. The applicant-institution for additional unit will be required to submit the required documents such as land documents, Encumbrance Certificate (EC), Land Use Certificate (LUC), Building Plan (BP) and the Approved Staff List in the specified proforma available on the website to the Regional Committee in proof of having provided additional facilities before October 31, 2015. Building Completion Certificate (BCC) may be given along with other documents if available, otherwise it can also be given to the Visiting team at the time of inspection.
 - V. The Regional Committees shall arrange for verification of documents, inspection of these premises and check adherence to these conditions by 20 Feb, 2016. If it is found by the Regional Committee that the institution fails to comply with these requirements, the institutions shall not be permitted to admit students for the academic year 2016-2017
- **5. NOW THEREFORE,** in the light of the above and in terms of Section 14(3) of NCTE Act and in accordance with the Regulations, 2014, the Southern Regional Committee, NCTE hereby grants recognition to **Kamaraj College of Education, Nadar Mahajana Sangam, Pazhavilai Post, Kanyakumari District-629501, Tamilnadu** for conducting **B.Ed** programme of **two** years duration with an annual intake of **100** students each for two basic units from the academic session **2015-16** subject to fulfilment of the conditions mentioned at 4.(II) and 4.(II) herein before 31st July, 2015 and those mentioned at 4.(III), 4.(IV) before 31.10.2015.

PREAMBLE:

In terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 Kamaraj College of Education, Nadar Mahajana Sangam, Pazhavilai Post, Kanyakumari District, Pin – 629501, Tamilnadu had submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for B.Ed course on 30.12.2004.

SRC-NCTE caused inspection of the institution on 03.11.2005 as NOC is dated 04.08.2005. Upon consideration of visiting team report and other documents furnished by the institution, the SRC in its 104th meeting held on 8th and 9th November 2005 decided to accord recognition for B.Ed programme with an intake of 100 from the academic session 2006-07.

However, in the meanwhile some institutions who have been granted recognition for the subsequent year based on belated endorsements preferred an appeal to NCTE Hqrs. and contended that a few institutions which have submitted belated endorsements were grated recognition for the current academic year. SRC, in its comments to the NCTE Hqrs. explained that this has occurred due to oversight and would modify such orders which have been wrongly issued. Pursuant to this, the National Council for Teacher Education, New Delhi, No.F.No.89-156/2005-Appeal dated 28th September, 2005 remanded back the cases to the SRC, Bangalore with a direction to reconsider the cases immediately for granting recognition from 2005-2006 on par with other similar cases who have been granted recognition for 2005-2006.

The same has been placed before SRC in its 103rd meeting held on 27th and 28th October, 2005 and SRC after obtaining a considered legal opinion in this regard, has taken a decision to review its recognition orders issued for the session 2006-07 and to grant recognition for the session 2005-06 to those institutions who have submitted belated NOCs/Endorsements as one time exception. Subsequently, SRC in its 104th meeting held on 9th November, 2005 decided to extend this relaxation to the institutions which have submitted other essential documents mentioned in Appendix 1B, belatedly.
